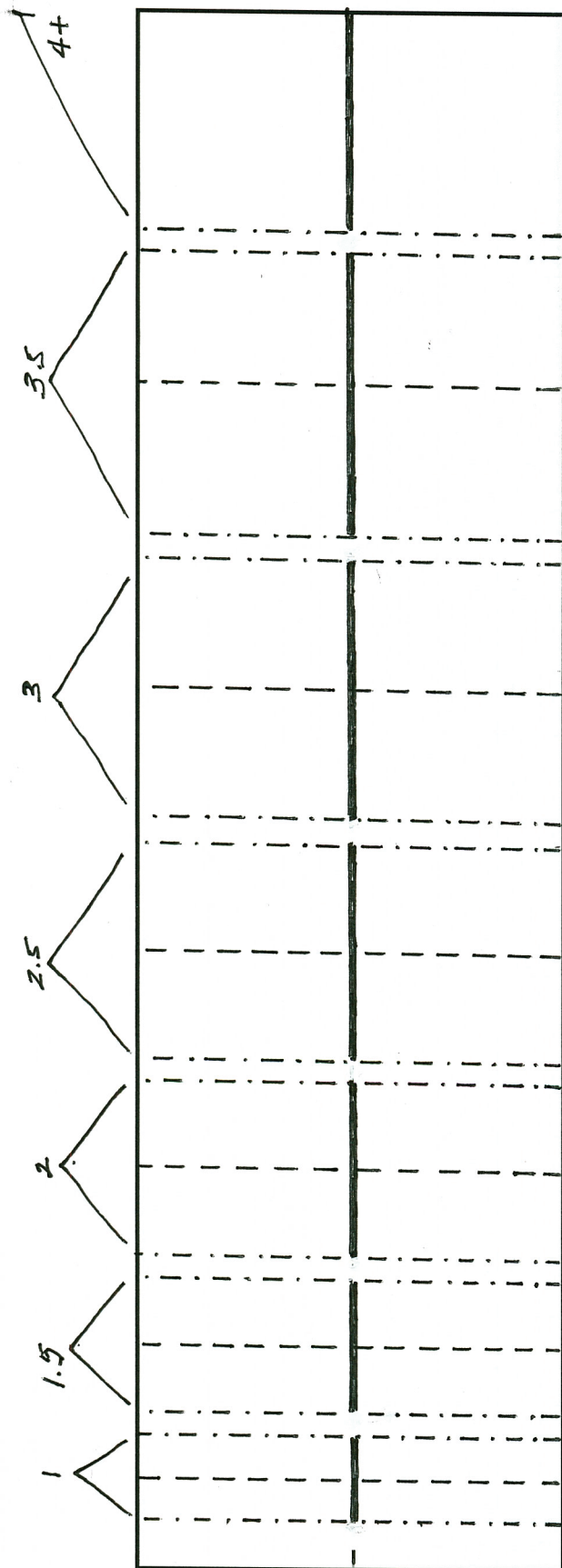


Fishbone Folding Technique, Lily Hoy



Valley fold

Mountain fold

Cut

Do not trim the paper for the last "bone" section since it will need to be longer to account for the folds to align it to the fore-edge.

Note: Folding according to the absolute inch measurements will result in slight imperfections to the alignment against the fore-edge because of the paper weight and the folds. Heavier paper makes thicker folds. If you want the bone sections to align perfectly to the fore-edge, you need to adjust the folds according to where the paper fell on the prior fold rather than the indicated inch measurements. I tried it with Arches Text Wave paper which is not really that thick (120 gsm.) because it comes in a 40" length and folds well without falling apart.
